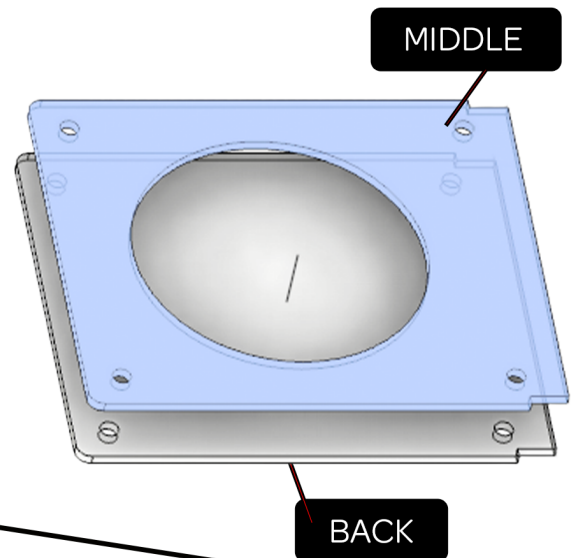

THE WORST PART

Before you assemble your stand, you will need to remove this super annoying protective film from each piece. We would have rather done this for you, and we did try – but no matter what we did, we could not keep our greasy fingerprints off of the plastic. **We did include a small removal tool.** You can use this to peel away the protective film. Use it at the corners of each acrylic piece to start a peel, then use your fingers to pull off the rest.

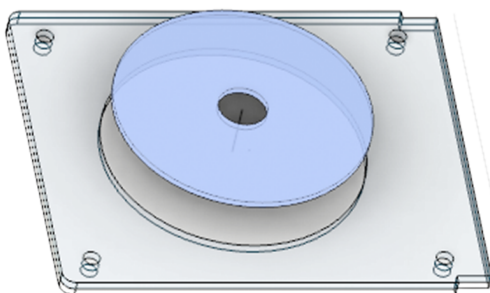
STEP 1

Once all protective film is removed, get your favourite game disc. Ready? Place the part marked **Back** flat on a clean, level surface. Next, place the part marked **Middle** on top of the **Back** piece. Line them up so they stack evenly on top of each other.



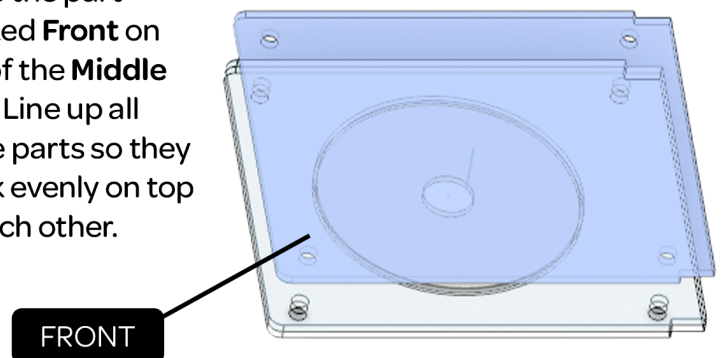
STEP 2

Place your game disc face up (label looking at you) in the center of the **Middle** piece. Don't worry if the disc isn't perfectly rotated, you can shake it in the right position later.



STEP 3

Place the part marked **Front** on top of the **Middle** part. Line up all three parts so they stack evenly on top of each other.

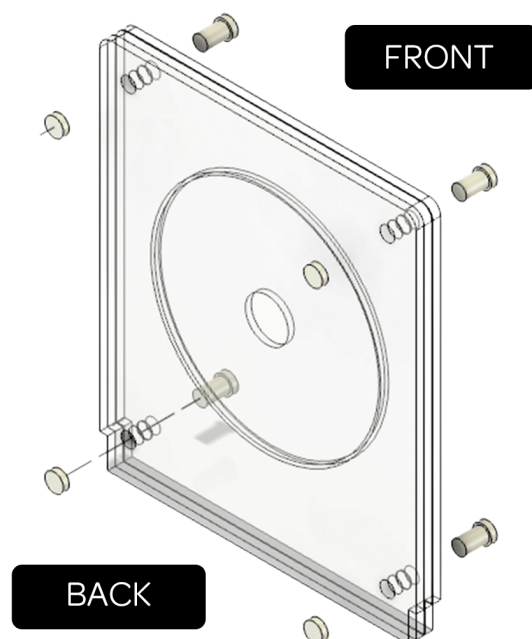


STEP 4

Grab the bag marked **Fasteners**. In the bag, there is 4 sets of fasteners, each has a **barrel** and **cap**. Empty the bag, knolling them into two piles – cap and barrels – so you can easily grab them as you work through each fastener.

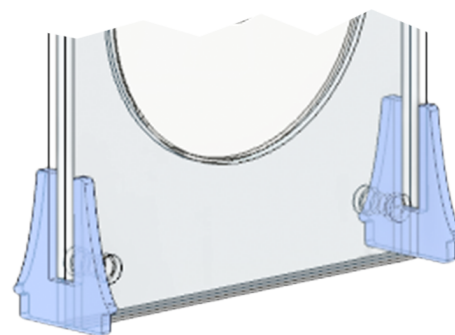
Pick up all three parts, with the game disc locked between them.

Insert a barrel into one of the holes from the **front of the display**. On the other side, hand screw in the cap, then lightly tighten with a star-shaped screw driver. **Do not overtighten**. Do this three more times to fasten each corner.



STEP 5

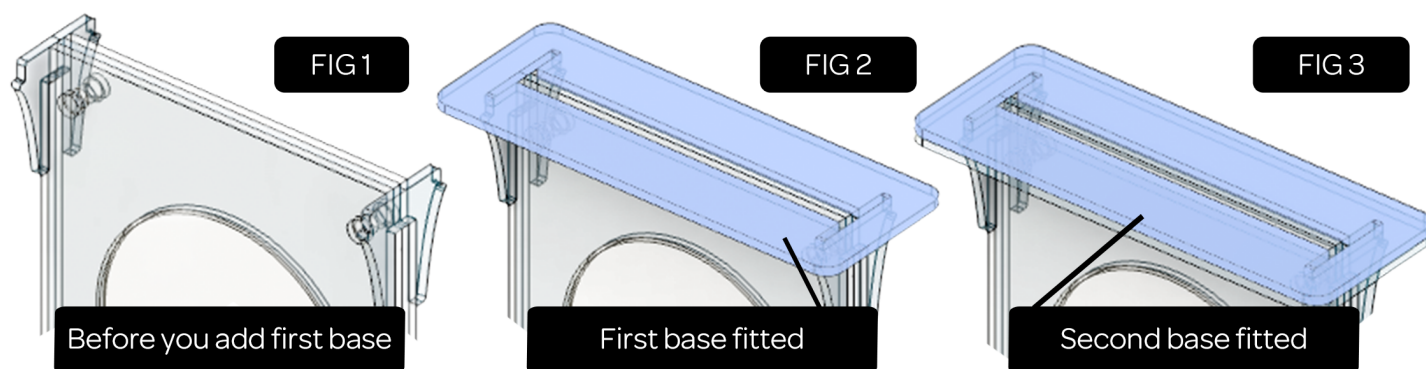
Slide each part marked **Stabilizer** onto the left and right bottom of the assembled display.



STEP 6

Turn the assembled display upside down so you are looking at the bottom of it (Fig 1).

Then grab the **two** parts marked **Base**. Starting with just one of the parts, **gently** slide it over the bottom of the assembly (Fig 2). Then grab the second **Base** and place it on top of the last **Base** part (Fig 3).



You are done assembling your game disc display! If the disc is not positioned perfectly, you can gently tap the side of the display stand repeatedly to get it in the right placement.
