DECIDING ON MOUNTING METHOD

Each FloatShelf includes 3M Command Strips and EZAnchor anchors and fasteners. Decide on one or the other – using both methods is overkill.

- 3M Command Strips: removable, no damage method - one-time use with ability for slight adjustment.
- EZ Anchors: strong, permanent solution for drywall; leaves walls with minimal damage if removed.

There is no wrong choice – it just comes down to your considerations. If you live in an apartment or rented space, you may find 3M Command Strips are the most appropriate. A gameroom, or other place where you don't expect to move your games around makes EZAnchors – the self-drilling, low mess anchor – the appropriate method.

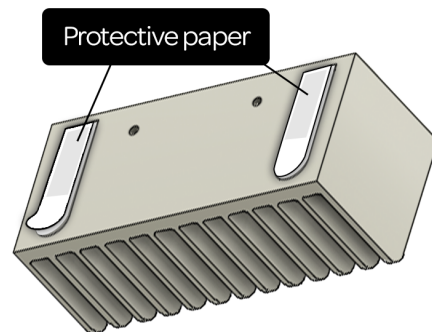
3M COMMAND STRIPS

Clean wall with rubbing alcohol. Do not use household cleaners.

With Command Strips pressed onto FloatShelf (shipped with them already attached), remove protective paper from the strips that stick to the wall. Firmly press FloatShelf to the wall for 30 seconds.

Pull FloatShelf away from the wall, decoupling from the Command Strips.

Place your FloatShelf some place safe for now.



3M COMMAND STRIPS CONTINUED...

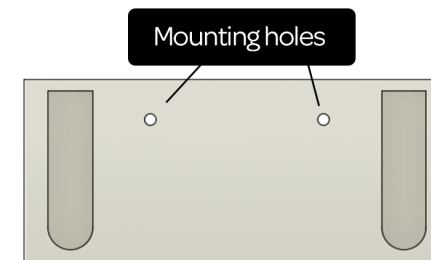
With FloatShelf out of the way, apply more pressure to the Command Strips that are mounted on the wall, ensuring they are adhering to the wall well.

Wait one hour, then align your FloatShelf to the Command Strips on the wall and press firmly until you hear a bunch of velcro-y sounds (this is the science term for this phenomenon).

EZANCHORS & FASTENERS

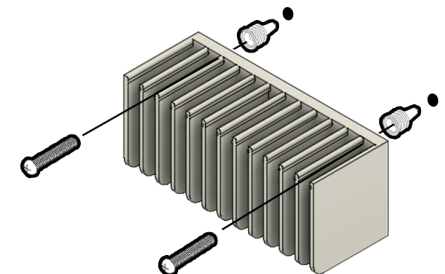
Get yourself a level, a star-shaped screwdriver and a pen.

Place FloatShelf against the wall where you want to mount it. With your level, make sure FloatShelf is level, then using your pen – mark within the two mounting holes. Once done, place FloatShelf some where safe.



Use the star-shaped screwdriver to drill the EZAnchors into the two areas you marked with your pen.

Place FloatShelf back on the wall. Insert each screw and slowly fasten it into the wall – do not over-fasten.
