



WiiU + Gamepad Wall Mount

STEP 1

First, scout out a good location on a drywall-based wall to mount your Wii U. It is **important to check that:**

- Make sure the location gives space for the disc to eject
- HDMI and power cables will reach the WiiU and Wii U GamePad when mounted
- You are mounting the WiiU horizontally, not vertically

On the **reverse side of this paper** is a template that you can use to define the points for mounting the brackets of this product.

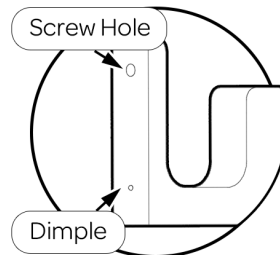
Place the paper against the wall, ensure that the paper is level. Next, use a pen to mark the two points shown on the paper. These two points will represent where you will screw/drill in the included anchors and screws.

STEP 2

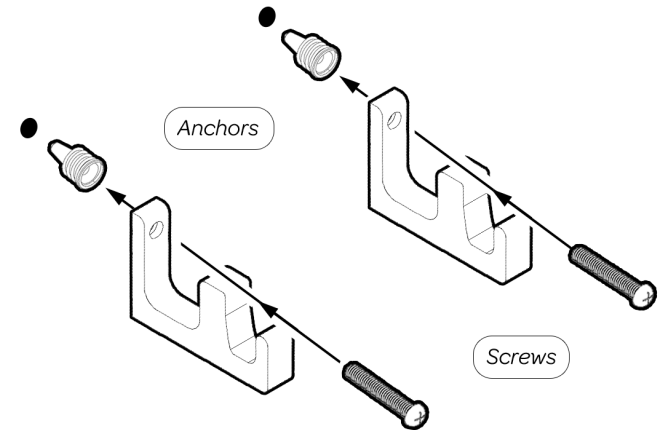
This product comes with two brackets. In Step 1 you marked two points, one for each bracket. Please **take note of the dimple on the back of each bracket**. This helps keep each bracket in place.

Use a star-headed screwdriver to drill two of the included anchors into the marked points from Step 1. Then the two screws – take one bracket at a time and drill the screws with the bracket in place. Tighten these screws as far as possible, but do not over-tighten.

Get ready to mount your WiiU + GamePad to the wall. We're almost there.



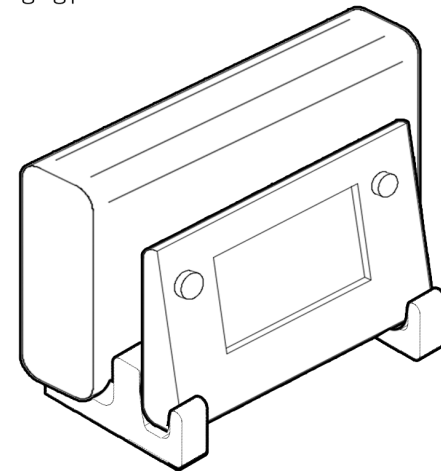
STEP 2, CONTINUED



STEP 3

Slide the Wii U console into the larger slot located on the brackets you have mounted to your wall. Hook up your HDMI, power and light bar (if necessary).

Slide the WiiU GamePad into the smaller slot. You can charge the GamePad from the top charging port connector.

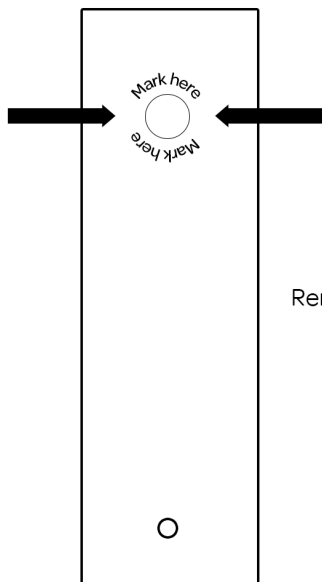

Mounting Bracket Placement Template

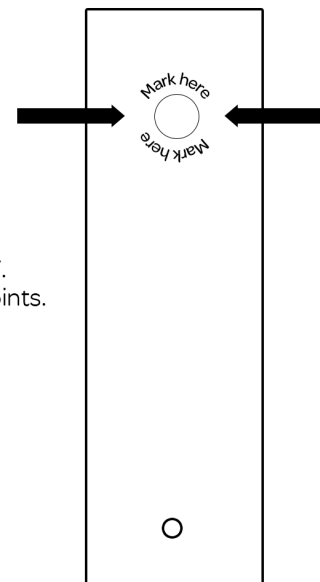
Level this page on your wall, then use a pen to mark the points labeled "Mark here".
