

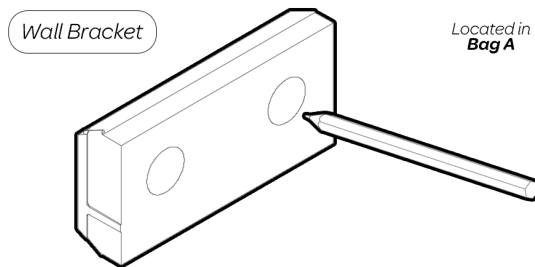


PitStop Shelf for Mario Kart Live: Home Circuit

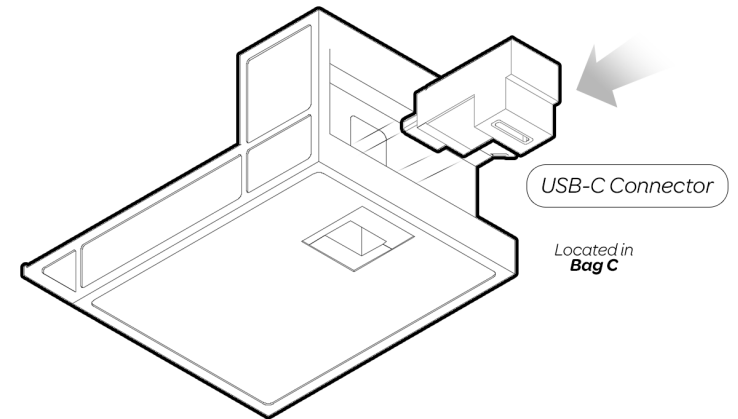
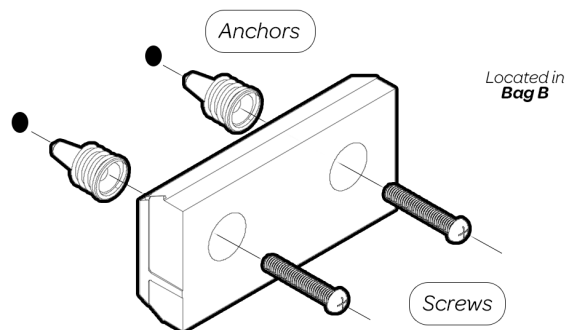
MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

First, find the place where you want to mount your PitStop Shelf. Consider the length of USB cable you are using, and if it will reach PitStop Shelf without straining the cable.

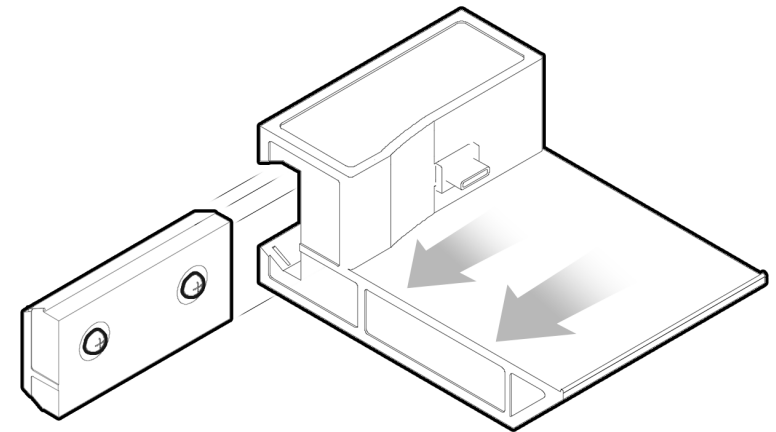
Next, take the Mounting Bracket from Bag A and place it on the wall you want to mount to. Use a pencil to mark two holes for your anchors, located in Bag B.



Grab your star-headed screwdriver and the two anchors in Bag B. To fasten the anchor, you do not need to pre-drill or use any special tools. Use your screwdriver to screw the anchors into the markings you made earlier. Once the anchors are in the wall, take your Wall Bracket and align it with the holes in the wall and fasten the two included screws (Bag B) into the Wall Bracket. Make sure that the Wall Bracket is tight enough that it does not wiggle around.



Once the Wall Bracket is secured to the wall, grab the USB-C connector in Bag C and slide it into the back of the PitStop Shelf. Ensure that it is pressed all the way in.



Carefully slide PitStop Shelf over the Wall Bracket. Press PitStop Shelf all the way to the left. It is secure when the Wall Bracket and PitStop Shelf are flush with each other. You will feel the Wall Bracket and PitStop Shelf clip together firmly.

You can now insert your USB-C cable into the bottom of PitStop Shelf. Once connected, place your Mario Kart (or Luigi) onto PitStop Shelf. Your Kart should connect with the USB-C charging connector. The Kart is properly connected when the USB-C charging connector is snug and feels attached.
